- Mixed with toucans, aracaris, tanagers, cardinals, troupials, cock-of-the-rock, motmots, cotingas, guira cuckoos, macaw species, conures, various waterfowl.
- Tamarins (works for some, not others).
 Plush-crested jays will break eggs.
- Frequent challenges with other larger ground birds such as grey-winged trumpeters & sunbitterns.



- Mixed with turacos, mousebirds, weavers, starlings, red-billed hornbills, barbets, hamerkops, ibis, lapwings, various waterfowl.
- In larger aviaries they have been successfully kept with various storks, cranes, and vultures.

 fruit doves, birds-of-paradise, mynahs,
 bulbuls, liocichlas, fairy bluebirds, and various
 waterfowl.







- Mix well with crested wood partridge, Nicobar pigeons, fruit doves, azure-winged magpies, laughingthrushes, shamas, mynahs, bulbuls, liocichlas, birds-of-paradise, various waterfowl.
- Mixed reviews with Palawan peacock pheasants.



- Mix well with crested wood partridge, Nicobar pigeons, fruit doves, mynahs, bulbuls, liocichlas, pittas, various waterfowl.
- Mixed reviews with Malay great argus.







 Mixed with red-billed blue magpies, azurewinged magpies, laughingthrushes, bulbuls, leiothrix, and a wide variety of waterfowl.
