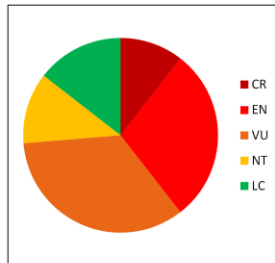

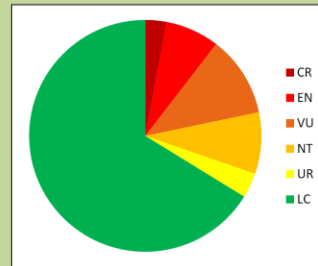

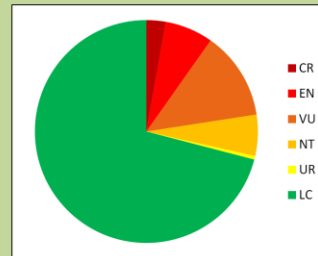
43% of the reviewed Parrot Taxa are threatened with extinction!

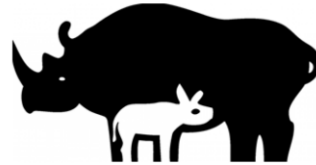

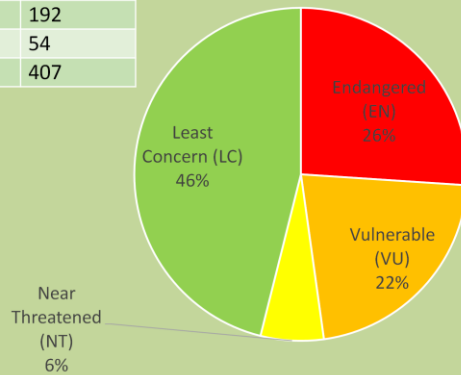
We decided to do a “space survey” not because we do not know if space is available but because we want to increase the awareness about Amazons

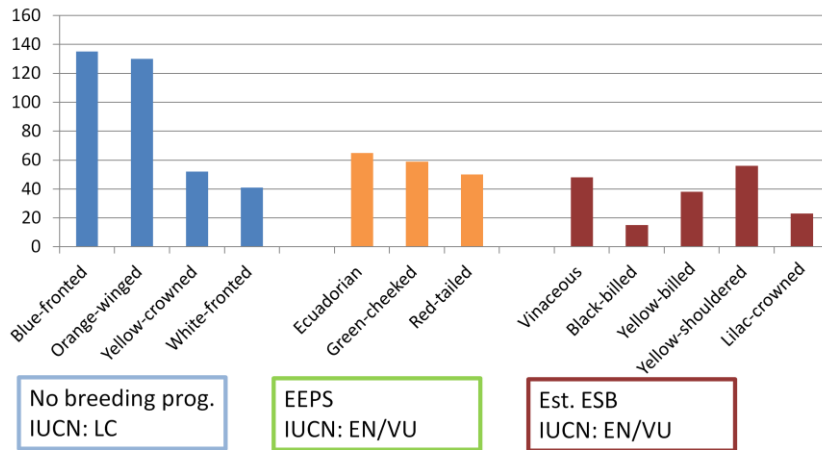

Amazon parrots in EAZA



EEP species only take up 17% of available spaces. Critics says that is all follow the recommended lists there will be less diversity in zoos. In this situation the reverse is the case! Anthony Dabadie from Branfere zoo in France is approaching holders of Orange-winged Amazon directly looking to place many as non-breeding in a single facility and alternatively place program species.

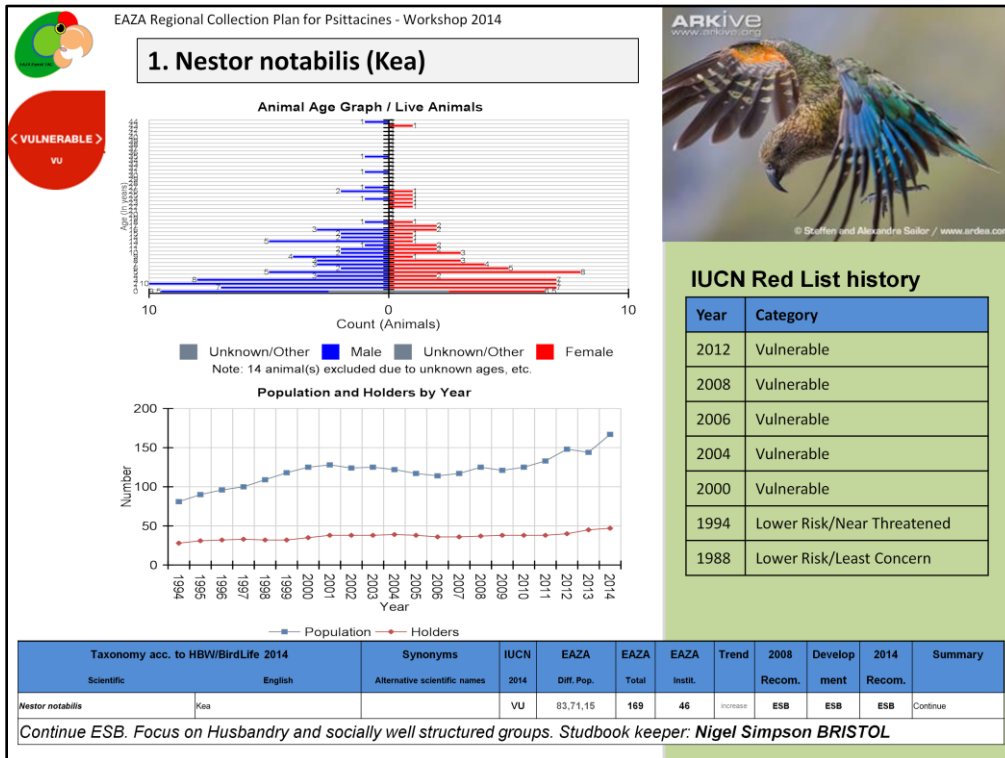



Age (in years) vs Count (Animals)








